The grant funds will be used to support an art show comprised of artwork from local high school students attending the following schools; TC Central High School, TC West High School, TC High School, St. Francis High School, TC Christian, TC East Middle School, TC West Middle School, and St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Middle School.
