TBACU Donates to Children's Advocacy Center

Traverse City, MI – On December 19, 2018, TBA Credit Union presented a check for \$1,500 to Traverse Bay Children's Advocacy Center.

The donation will help benefit the organization, a regional response center for the protection and well-being of children. Since 2010, the center has been the first stop for children who are suspected victims of sexual and physical abuse or who have witnessed a violent crime. Their mission is to protect children by providing prevention education and multi-disciplinary intervention in an environment that is child-sensitive, supportive, and safe.

The donations were comprised of raffle ticket sales from TBACU's annual holiday party as well as separate, direct donations. Every year, staff members select a non-profit who will benefit from the ticket sales and the Children's Advocacy Center was selected as the 2018 recipient.
